

## **2009 United Kingdom and Ireland Summer Show Tour Itinerary, July 19 – August 10, 2009**

**July 19, Sunday To Camp Wisdom, Dallas, Texas, 375 miles**

**July 20, Monday Flight to Ireland, a. 5500 miles**

Breakfast and to DFW Airport by 9 am.

**July 21, Tuesday Arrive Shannon, Bus to Galway, 50 miles**

Land in Shannon, Ireland at 7:00 am. We will work through the incoming process and board our bus provided by Marshall's Coach Company of London.

Visit the Cliffs of Moher, and the Burren before arriving in Galway for a performance hosted by Eamon Hartley and the Renmore Scouts. We will perform for one hour and spend the night at the Renmore Scout Den.

**July 22, Wednesday, Galway to Dungarvan, Ireland 130 miles**

Visit Blarney Castle along the way to Dungarvan. Our host is Brian Mulvihill, and we will perform at 8 pm at Dungarvan Town Hall. We will spend the night at Mount Melleray Internation Scout Activity Center.

**July 23, Thursday, to Dublin, Ireland, 135 miles**

Perform matinee for Dublin Scouts and our host, Pat Hollingsworth, at Dublin Scout Hut at 3:30 pm. Attend Riverdance performance at the Gaiety Theater at 8 pm. We will spend the night at the Dublin Scout Hut.

**July 24, Friday, to Belfast, Northern Ireland, 140 miles**

Visit the Bru' na Ba; inne Visitor Center and tour the ancient Knowth Tomb. Cross into N. Ireland for a view of Belfast and a full performance at the Belfast Opera House in the evening. Our host is Dr. David Hutchinson. We will spend the night at the National Scout Campsite near Crawfordsburn.

**July 25, Saturday, to Galway, England, 230 miles**

Ride Belfast Stranraer Ferry across Irish Sea to Troon, Scotland, then on across southwestern Scotland to Galway. Our host is Don McCutcheon. Evening performance and lodging at Ratlingate Scout Campsite.

**July 26, Sunday, to Edinburgh, Scotland, and back to Galway, 240 miles**

Visit Edinburgh, Scotland and Edinburgh Castle. Return to Galway for lodging again at Ratlingate Scout Campsite.

**July 27, Monday, to Prudhoe, 90 miles**

Visit Hadrian's Wall and perform in evening at Prudhoe Community High School. Our host is Sue Charlesworth. We will spend the night at the East Center.

**July 28, Tuesday, to Hesse, 150 miles**

Visit The Deep Subaquarium and evening performance at Hesse Town Hall. Our host is Keith O'Brien. We will spend the night at the Raywell Scout Activity Center in Cottingham.

**July 29, Wednesday, to Urmston, 105 miles**

Visit the Leeds Armoury. Our host is Bob Spoons. Evening performance at the Urmston Leisure Centre. Lodging at the Davyhulme Scout Hut across the street.

**July 30, Thursday, to Manchester, 20 miles**

Visit the Imperial War Museum and the Trafford Centre (biggest retail, culinary, and leisure outlet in Europe) for some retail therapy. Our host is Barry Aitken. Perform in Stockport at the 1<sup>st</sup> Bramhall's Centenary Celebration. We will be joined in the performance by the 3<sup>rd</sup> Davyhulme Scout & Guide Band of Manchester. Lodging will be in the Scout Headquarters Bramley Center.

**July 31, Friday, to Gloucester, England, 115 miles**

Visit the Cathedral Cloister, site of the filming of Harry Potter films. Our hosts are Neil Harden, Mark Stapleton, and the Forest of Dean Explorer Scouts. Performance at the GL1 Center. Lodging at The Wilderness Center.

**August 1, Saturday, to Bournemouth, 120 miles**

Our host is Alistair Henderson. Visit Corfe Castle, ride steam train to Swanage, perform in main arena at Swanage Fair. Perform again in the evening for local Explorer Scouts after BBQ at Leeson House, and watch fireworks display.

**August 2, Sunday, Visit Brownsea Island, then to Plymouth, 120 miles**

Ferry across to Brownsea Island from Studland Beach with Tsunami Explorer Scouts transporting us in their own flotilla, attend church service at St. Mary's Church on Brownsea Island, visit Baden Powell original campsite and memorial with talk by Baden Powell expert, enjoy sack lunch, the ferry back with Tsunami Explorer Scouts. Visit Mayflower Steps on the Barby in Plymouth. Evening performance at lodging at Mount Tamar School.

**August 3, Monday, to Tolmer's Scout Camp near Cuffley, 260 miles**

**August 7, Friday, to Radlette, 30 miles**

**August 8, Saturday, To Paris via "The Chunnel", 280 miles**
